From I-81 South take exit 191B toward the Scranton Expressway (Scranton Carbondale Hwy), follow the Scranton Expressway towards Central City, Scranton. Proceed through seven (7) stop lights to Jefferson Avenue. Get in the left lane. Turn left, proceed straight on Jefferson Avenue; The Regional Hospital of Scranton will be on your right. Enter doors on East Gibson Street side (where you see 2 large white columns). Enter elevator on left and proceed to the 5th Floor.
